About God’s Littlest Angels

God’s Littlest Angels is an amazing orphanage in Haiti that recently received 200 more orphans after the earthquake in Haiti. The average child spends 18 months – 2 years at their facility until they are adopted. The cost per child for that 2 year stay is \$12,500. That’s 2.5 million dollars for the 200 orphans that they just received. That cost includes

medical care (they have a NICU on site), court costs and lawyer fees in addition to room and board. They are not funded by the government; only by private donors from the U.S., Canada and France.
